K-12 Curriculum: Superintendent Degenfelder: Curriculum portal and teacher conference. Themed around Wyoming and civics education. Fall conferences in 2025 give them the tools to get kids pumped up in the proceeding school year.

Marketing: Diane Shober: Using existing vendors to develop the logo (should be ready 1st of June), marketing budget and proposal. Contact with Madden media for microsite for taskforce, July 1, 2024 phase 1, October 31, 2024 phase 2. Initial Website covered under WOT, will need budget for maintenance in new Bienimum. Will have an approval process for everything that goes on to the website.
